- Meeting was opened with prayer.

- There are five proposed rule changes voted on during the meeting:

 - 2. Raise the penalty for dead fish from one-quarter pound to one-half pound. FAILED.
 - 3. Disallow the culling of any dead fish. **REMOVED** by the Submitter.
 - 4. Establish an echeloned approach for solving major grievances between members or violations in the club which could potentially result in removal of a member. The resolution between the tournament director and the two. If not resolved, the tournament director will pick three at large committee members to work the case with the members. If that is not resolved, then the grievance will come before the entire club for final disposition. **FAILED.**
 - 5. Change the payouts from one in two to One in three. **REMOVED** by Submitter.
- The following were elected officers for next year: President, Jim Wimmer; Tournament Director, Ed Walker; Secretary, Quentin Hopkins; Treasurer, Bernie Belville.
- A motion was made to form a committee to review club by-laws and fishing rules for excess requirements. The following agreed to serve on the committee: Jim Wimmer, Tom Weigand, Jim Cushman, Red Calhoun, and David Sisk.
- The draw for our November tournament was accomplished. Nine boats and 18 members will be fishing 8:00 to 3:00.
- Meeting was adjourned.
